"SAFETY INCENTIVE 2000"

NEW COMPANY WIDE SAFETY INCENTIVE:

By maintaining a company wide accident free record for six consecutive months, every field employee will earn one day off with pay to be used at their discretion. You can earn a possibility of two days off with pay by achieving all twelve months accident free. Remember this is a company wide incentive and we must work together to receive the incentive.

In the event that someone was an accident requiring either medical attention or time off from work, the six month period will start over again.

Attention new employees: you must be with the company for at least three consecutive months prior to the achievement in order to be eligible. Employees who have worked for more than three

months but less than the full six months will receive one half day off with pay.

You will be updated on the status of company accidents on the Safety Scoreboard each month. We are within **82** days of meeting the first six month period. Let's all do our part to make it happen.
